- IPPW (Integrated Primary Prevention Workforce), it is an important effort and also a congressional mandate.
- Encouraged the reading of the Executive Summary of the National Defense Strategy. You can find the unclassified document on the internet with your chosen search browser.

Deployments continue. Many Soldiers returned

from numerous deployments this year, and a significant number of Airmen will be deploying this coming year.

- State Active Duty is always a possibility and likely with the SW Boarder. Gov Noem wants to do it right, not hastily, with much forward planning.
- State Tuition Assistance Enhancement Bill: expansion to private schools.

Defend the Guard Bill: National movement trying to change the way the Guard is mobilized. Department of the Military is opposed to the bill, as written it is not good for the Guard.


